- Walls → openness, visual distraction, expansion of classrooms
  - Integrated storage, writing/presentation space
- Acoustics → Individual/group privacy, sound control, surfaces
- Lighting → Daylight, glare, efficiency
- Remodeling for personalized learning
  - Selective removal of walls
  - Replace with operable partitions
  - Storage consolidation
  - Free up wall space for interactive surfaces
