Re: Food Service Adjustment for Breakfast Claims

Due to opening the new Manawa Middle School entity, breakfast claims for this entity only will be reduced for the first three months of the 2020-21 school year and the first three months of the 2021-22 school year.

For the past several years, over 40% of families that qualify for Free or Reduced meal pricing utilize the meal program in both schools. This had allowed each school at the School District of Manawa to be a school with Severe Needs. School with Severe Needs, government reimbursement rates are higher for breakfasts.

Because the Manawa Middle School does not have an established utilization rate for families, it will require 3 months before it is possible to qualify. During this time, reimbursement rates for the Manawa Middle School free or reduced priced breakfasts only will be less.
