



Graphic House, Inc. hereby warrants the sign display against defective workmanship in construction and assembly for one (1) year from the date of the invoice. Faux Corten has a warranty of two (2) years for finish deterioration. No other warranties will apply. All labor for repair of electronic message centers or time and temperature units are covered under warranty for one (1) year from date of installation. All components/parts for electronic message centers or time and temperature units are covered under warranty as outlined by manufacturer. Graphic House, Inc. does not warranty flags. No other warranties or guarantees are expressed or implied, either written or verbal. All warranties will be null and void if anyone other than Graphic House, Inc. services or maintains the signage specified on this proposal, or if the final invoice for this proposal is not paid in full within 45 days of the final invoice date.

Our warranty, and warranties by stand-alone subassemblies manufactured by other companies, are based solely on the client's responsibility to properly maintain, service and clean these sign components at no longer than each six-month interval. This warranty does not apply to vandalism, misuse, acts of God, and war.

Any deviation from prints or altered foundations will weaken the structure to the point that it may fail. This structure is engineered to hold only the signage specified. Do not add additional signage to the structure.

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Any changes in the plans or specifications from the date this proposal and prints are approved and authorized will result in an administrative fee of \$400 per change plus the cost of the change. Any changes or extras may extend the time to complete the manufacturing and/or services specified.

Any alteration or deviation from the above specifications involving extra costs will be executed and will become an extra charge over and above the estimate, together with the terms and conditions set forth in the attached addendum which is incorporated herein in its entirety. Re:	High/Middle Art Display Panels

The purpose of this memo is to follow up and inform the Building and Grounds Committee of the purchase and initiation of a project for the Art Department at Manawa Middle/Little Wolf High School . This project will be funded by the Sturm Memorial Grant. This particular grant is rotated among the music and the arts. Mrs. Zabler and Mrs. Bortle have worked together with the representative Ted Tracanna on the design, fabric selection, placements and measurements. The purpose of the art display boards is to provide an aesthetically pleasing display for our student art for family members, community and for our school. The team has been planning this project for a number of years, and it now can come into fruition.

Questions the committee referred to the Safety reviews by MacNeil Environment:

These references are right from our Safety reviews by MacNeil Environmental:

IFC code 807.5.2.2 (corridors) & IFC code 807.5.2.3 (classrooms)

• Artwork and teaching materials shall be permitted to be attached directly to the walls and shall not exceed 20 percent of the wall area in a corridor and 50 percent of the wall area in a classroom.

The 20/50 percent refers to the wall area of each wall space and not the aggregate wall area of a room or space

Bookshelves placed against a wall or built-in are part of the wall surface, however books places on the shelves are not part of the 50 percent provision.

NFPA 10.19.3.1 (ceiling) & NFPA 10.19.3.2.1 (sprinklers)

• Storage and other obstructions must be at least 18" below the sprinkler head. Storage in buildings without automatic sprinkler systems must keep at least 2 feet from the ceiling.

A clearance of at least 36" must be maintained around all sprinkler control valves.

Kelly Marinoff from McNeil Environments reviewed the blueprints, measurements, purpose and location of the proposed art panels. Her question/response was:

Are the panels fire retardant? If so, then only 50% per wall can be covered with flammable materials ((paper, cardboard, netting, etc.) in hallways. Doesn't matter if you have panels or not, if the panels are not fire proof then they cannot be used. They do make a spray that can be applied. I hope this has helped.

When sharing this with Mr. Ted, he did some research on the material for the art panels, and obtained the information:

Fire rating for Guilford Fabric Material

Class A

ASTM 84

(High rated for fire.)

When reviewing this proposal, it is flame safe, and the art teachers, when displaying student art, will keep it below the 50% in covering the walls.

With the newly researched information, I recommend approving the art panels funded by the Sturm Memorial Grant. By applying the art work to the panels as opposed to attaching them directly to the wall, this provides a more secure display as well as one that does not damage the paint/walls when displaying student art.
