Re: Recommendation for 1.0 FTE HS Science Teacher

This memo is to recommend Mr. William Lund as a long-term substitute teacher for the 1.0 FTE High School Science teaching position, for the first semester of the 2017-18 school year.

Mr. Lund is a veteran teacher from Iola, Wisconsin. His tenure as a master teacher spanned forty-one years at the School District of Iola. Mr. Lund holds a Life License from the state of Wisconsin and holds certifications in General Science, Chemistry, Physics, and Physical Science. He received his Bachelor of Science degree from Ferris State University and U.W. - Green Bay and his Master of Science degree in Environmental Science from U.W. - Green Bay.

In addition to his passion for science, Mr. Lund is the Co-Chairman and Assistant Manager for EAA KidVenture, and the Northern Aces Show Team. Students earn Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) credit toward an Airframe and/or Powerplant (A&P) certificate through hands-on building projects.

Iola Principal Sara Anderson states, "He has had a positive influence in the lives of countless students, including my own daughter and son. Mr. Lund not only taught the students biology and chemistry, he taught them how to be good citizens, how to think beyond themselves and that they could accomplish anything they wanted to if they applied themselves."
