ATV/UTV must be registered. Registration permits operation of an ATV/UTV on a paved highway or street that has a posted speed limit of 65 mph or less. Driver must possess a valid driver's license and the ATV/UTV must be able to attain a speed limit of 35 mph on a level driving surface.

Any student parking an ATV/UTV in the Little Wolf High School student parking lot must have a parking permit displayed on the ATV/UTV as instructed by the office. This must be visible for the staff monitoring the parking lot. Parking permits are \$10.00 for a full year, \$5.00 for a half year. Parking fines are \$10.00 each time your ATV/UTV does not have a permit displayed for staff and/or police to see.

Random parking lot checks are made throughout the year. One of the conditions for granting permission for a student to bring a student-operated vehicle onto school premises is written consent by the student driver, the owner of the vehicle, and the parent of the student to allow search of that vehicle. Refusal by any of the parties to provide or allow access to a vehicle at the time of a search request shall be cause for terminating the privilege without further hearing.

Students are not allowed to park in the front of the building, on the grass, or in the other designated staff parking areas. If a student needs to park in the handicapped zones, please contact the office for arrangements. Students participating in sports are also required to park their vehicles in the STUDENT PARKING LOT, not in front of the building.
