### **New Business:**

Football/Wrestling Website: Brad Johnson has put together a new website for Football and Wrestling. Link is on the School Website. We took a look at it and it is awesome. Website is a great way to communicate with the team.

Football Money form Rodeo: Motion by Heather, second by Shae to start a new line item for the Treasury Report for Football so fund like this can be deposited to the Booster Club and used at the Head Football Coaches discretion.

Aircat Matchine: Scott Rice came and presented information about an Air Cat Volleyball Pitching Machine which throws serves, passes and throws different types of sets. This would allow the coaches to stand beside the student and make corrections vs tossing the ball to them. There was a financing item, however the Booster Club does not want to get involved with loans again as they did with the MAC Fund. The cost is \$3,600.00 delivered. We have a donation that was given to the Booster Club for \$1800 towards this machine. Motion by Mary, second by Nick to donate \$1800.00 for the balance of the Aircat Machine. It was determined that all the money from the Bags and Ball Tournament would go directly to the Booster Club and not be split 60/40 with the Mac Fund to repay our donation. All were in favor. Nate Ziemer was directed to order the machine.

Wrestling Mat: It was asked by the Youth Wrestling Club if donations could be directed to the Booster Club so they are tax deductible as the Wrestling Club wishes to purchase a new wrestling mat so that it would only be used for wrestling and not gym class to keep it cleaner and keep it from getting holes in it. There is a donor that will match up to \$100 for a total of \$1500 towards the new mat. Motion by Heather, second by Nick to approve. All were in favor. Further discussion around the air quality and concern as to why there are skin problems in the basement area. It was suggested that we go to the school board members on the Building and Grounds committee: Russ Hollman, Chuck Hebert and Russ Johnson and ask that the school do an Air Quality Test.

MYSA Request for Donation: The Manawa Youth Sports is once again having their golf outing and looking for donations. Motion by Heather, second by Nick to approve 2 - \$30.00 vouchers towards Booster Club Clothing and Bleacher Chairs in stock. All were in favor.

Lindsay Field Sponsor Sign Request: Carey Celske is asking for sponsorships for Lindsay Field Advertising Signs with the money going toward field improvement. Motion by Heather, second by Scott to approve \$400 one-time payment for a sign for the Booster Club. All were in favor except Nick Hericks. Motion Carried.
