

## Manawa Athletic Booster Club

### Meeting Minutes – May 4, 2016

Present were Michelle Kaczorowski, Mary Griffin, Brenda Krenke, Heather Wiesner, Nate Ziemer, Jeff Bortle, Nick Hericks, Pat Collins. Absent were Brianna Ibe, Brian Krenke, Shae Coyle, Brad Johnson, Scott Westphal and Heidi Westphal.

The Secretary's Minutes and Treasurer's Report from April 6<sup>th</sup> were reviewed. (To be approved at next meeting)

Jen Rosin was present to represent the Manawa Cowboys.

**Update from the AD:** Nate related that the school is looking into Safety Concerns following the Antigo shooting. They wish to keep the School as safe as possible by limiting access to the school that is not preapproved. It sounded very confusing to members of the booster club and there were several concerns that we had. Basically it addresses the access that would be spontaneous like unplanned open gym or Mary delivering her concessions during Christmas Vacation. He really didn't have a clear picture of what this would look like so it upset many of our members. Also concerns were raised regarding planned events getting bumped by event that were not on the calendar such as the Cowboy Registration in the commons bumped out by the Drama Club which caused problems with the large crowd and logistics. Shell showed up to take care of the Autism Puzzle Pieces in the commons and basically had to wait until someone found Mr. Wolfgram to approve it. We asked Nate to take our concerns back to the administration as we are very concerned about the outcome.

Football Equipment has been ordered and there seems to be a lot of interest in this year's program.

#### Old Business:

1. **Basketball 3-3 Tournament:** Pat said they haven't received any registrations yet. Sandy Cordes is working on T-shirt and she will lead up the registration on the day of. Brenda and Heather offered to help with Registration. Shell and Mary will take care of concessions. They are working on an officials list so anyone interested in helping, contact Pat Collins. Hoops may need some paint retouching. Checking on medals left over and if will need more. Will need help on Friday night painting the courts.
2. **Walkway Update:** Jeff and Nate are going to measure out the area behind the school and figure out what we would need for pavers as we only have 8 sold. They will report back at the next meeting.
3. **Hall of Fame:** Jeff is giving me the names of the individuals inducted and we are going to incorporate them into the posters.
4. **Weight Room Update:** Signs for the weight groups have been ordered from Carbon Freckle. They are reusable. We will also be purchasing rubber dumb bells and weights with the money. Some money will be set aside and not used for kids that reach certain levels in their weights to purchase T-Shirts. This will come out of funds raised for the Lift a thon. Brad is ordering T-Shirts for Lift a Thon and \$250 of that will be funded by Thrivent \$250 gift card provided by Mary Johnson.
5. **Bob Sell Appreciation:** Mary stated we need to start pushing tickets. The event is getting closer and Bear Lake will want a count soon. As soon as college students get home Garret will work on them.
6. **Spring Physicals & Parent Meetings:** Nate stated he has not had time to work on this yet.

7. **Aircat Machine:** Nate stated the Aircat Machine is here but he hasn't had time to put it together. Booster Club stated they would like a demonstration when it is put together.
  
8. **Wrestling Mat:** They have been ordered.
  
9. **Manawa Cowboys:** Mary read a letter from Jim Gorman regarding taking over the Cowboys and their needs for equipment coming up. A motion was made by Heather, second by Nick to approve a 50-50 split of the net proceeds of this year's Meet the Cowboys-Meet the Wolves to help with fundraising for the Cowboy Program in which Cowboy parents will help. We will re-evaluate next year. Since there is not a quorum, Mary will send an email to all members looking for approval and then we will reapprove at the next meeting.
  
10. **Summer Basketball/Volleyball Leagues:** There is a need for the Booster Club to pay for Summer Basketball and Volleyball Leagues so that our Coaches can participate. Motion was made by Brenda, second by Nick to approve up to \$250 each for Boy's Basketball, Girl's Basketball and Volleyball for Summer League Play. Since there is not a quorum, Mary will send an email to all members looking for approval and then we will reapprove at the next meeting.
  
11. **Bags and Balls Tournament:** We will move up the starting time as it was tight last year between Hall of Fame and Bags and Balls. Robin Dunnihoo has agreed to run the Bags Tournament again this year and Corrie Ziemer has agreed to run the Volleyball again. Mary/Shell/Heather will work on the Basketball Raffle and the 50/50 as that was a big fundraiser last year. If anyone would like to help with the basket raffle, let Shell know.
  
12. **5-5 Flag Football:** Brad is working on getting that up and running for the summer again.
  
13. **Rodeo Parade:** Please contact Troy and Heather Wiesner if you can help this year.
  
14. **Decals for Football Helmets:** Brad is asking if we would be willing to pay for the new decals on the helmets plus the award decals on the back for what they earn in play. The cost would be approximately \$350. Motion by Brenda, second by Jeff to pay for up to \$400 in decals for the Football Team. . Since there is not a quorum, Mary will send an email to all members looking for approval and then we will reapprove at the next meeting.
