

Library Loans & Limits

Little Wolf Jr./Sr. High students are allowed to have a maximum of five items checked out at any given time. The length of check-out depends upon the item type:

Books

- 3 weeks

Technology

- 1 day

Magazines

- 1 week

Students may also request to have up to five items that are currently checked out by another patron placed on hold.

Fines & Fees

Overdue Materials

- Books/Magazines - \$0.05/day
- Technology - \$0.50/day

Damaged Materials

When materials are returned in a damaged condition but are repairable, they will be assessed for damage and a fine will be given to cover the cost of repair. If materials are damaged beyond repair then the full cost of the material's replacement will be charged.

Lost Materials

When materials are lost, students will be charged for the replacement of the materials. If the item is found and returned to the library within the school year, a refund of the paid replacement cost will be made.

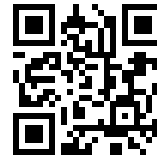
