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<u>Waupaca County Senior Nutrition Programs</u> A Look into Two Programs and a Request for Community Input.

According to the 2011 Wisconsin Aging Network Manual the purpose of the Senior Nutrition Program is to reduce hunger and food insecurities; promote socialization of older individuals, and promote the health and well-being of older individuals by assisting such individuals to gain access to nutrition and other disease prevention and health promotion services to delay the onset of adverse health conditions resulting from poor nutritional health or sedentary behavior. Waupaca County DHHS supports the nutritional needs of seniors through two separate programs:1. Congregate dining which is also known as senior dining and 2. the home delivered meal program.

- Range per meal cost by meal site = \$7.44 - \$16.84.
- Average meal donation amount = \$ 2.90.
- Suggested meal donation amount = \$ 4.25.
- Participation *decreased* by 9,000 meals over the last 5 years.

- Average cost per meal = \$8.24.
- Range per meal cost by distribution site = \$6.92-\$14.68.
- Average meal donation amount = \$ 1.80.
- Suggested meal donation amount = \$4.25.
- Participation *increased* 5,500 meals over the last 5 years.

The aging population in Waupaca County continues to grow. An increased need for home delivered meal service as well as decreased participation in congregate "senior dining" has been recognized. Overall Nutrition Program participation has decreased by 5% in the last 5 years while in that same time period the local tax dollar contribution as increased by 90%. In order to maintain the current level of service an additional \$87,000 of unbudgeted local tax dollars will be needed in 2019.
